Flip It!

I recently attended a webinar on "Hearing God" by Doug Addison. I boiled the notes down to nine key points, the first being in the form of a question: "Where are you being attacked right now?"

After identifying the area(s) of attack, we were then instructed to "flip it."

When we flip the assault, we picture what it looks like not as a problem but as a blessing. Spiritual warfare parallels regular warfare. For instance, if the Allied forces have possession of an oil depot, then it can be assumed that the fighting will be the heaviest around the depot because of the immense potential for whoever controls it. Satan's tactics involve discouraging you and creating fear in strategic areas in your life. He uses "what if" questions, facts, and hypotheticals to sow weeds into the field of your life.

What you are most afraid of are the areas God has actually targeted for your destiny. Hell targets these areas because they are key targets of heaven. The reasoning is, "Why is hell working so hard in a given person's life or why is the devil targeting certain situations and not others?" Think it through!

This is when and how you *flip it*. Take the problem before the Lord and picture it repaired and powerful in Christ. If you flip

the prodigal in your life, you see a potential Billy Graham or Joyce Meyer. Picture your prodigal teaching a Bible Study or discipling someone in Christ. If you flip a financial need where there is never enough and where you often struggle to make ends meet, you begin to see that is the area where God intends great blessing and prosperity for your future. *Flip it!* Where there are health issues, *flip it*, and begin to see that God's plan is that you enjoy health and strength with your youth being renewed like the eagles'.

When we *flip it*, we picture the end result through the eyes of faith. If we do not *flip it*, then fear, discouragement, and depression grow. It becomes more difficult to believe that the situation will ever be different. We begin to sink and lose hope, and so the oil depot changes hands from Allies' to Nazi Forces'.

Then, Nazi Forces become empowered, and we end up prisoners of what is actually meant to be our future.

But there are no lost causes in God's kingdom. There are only *found* causes. With

God, lost sheep get found. Lost coins are recovered. Prodigal sons come home. Those outside the Kingdom are called lost. *Amazing Grace* reminds us that we once were lost but now are found, were blind but now we see. *Flip it*.


Flip it becomes a valuable intercessory tool, especially for the situations where our faith is small. If guilt gnaws at you, *flip it!* If a prodigal is hopelessly gone, *flip it!* God knows exactly where he is and what he is thinking. Picture him lead-

ing a Bible Study (even if it is in jail!). Flip the situation and believe that God is empowering you to change His world, in Jesus's Name.
